- 8 "(B) Has received approval to offer and confer degrees by the Office of Degree Authorization 9 under ORS 348.606.".
- 10 Delete lines 23 through 30.
- 11 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 41.
- 12 In line 42, delete "3" and insert "2".
- 13 On page 3, line 20, delete "4" and insert "3".
- 14 In line 36, delete "5" and insert "4".
- 15 In line 37, delete "(a)".
- 16 Delete lines 42 through 45.
- 17 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 4.
- 18 Delete lines 44 and 45 and delete page 5 and insert:

"(7) There is established in the State Treasury a fund, separate and distinct from the General Fund, to be known as the For-Profit Independent Colleges Student Assistance Fund. Interest earned by the fund shall be credited to the fund. All moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission and shall be used to award For-Profit Independent College Grants under section 5 of this 2011 Act. The commission may accept funds for the fund from any source, public or private, and agree to conditions consistent with the provisions of section 5 of this 2011 Act.

26 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The Oregon Student Assistance Commission shall disburse grants to 27 qualified students enrolled in degree programs approved by the Office of Degree Authori-28 zation under ORS 348.606 at eligible post-secondary institutions from the For-Profit Inde-29 pendent Colleges Student Assistance Fund established in ORS 348.570 (7).

"(2) The commission shall adopt rules governing the disbursement of grants under this
section.

32 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> Students may first apply for For-Profit Independent College Grants under
33 section 5 of this 2011 Act on or after January 1, 2013.

34 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
35 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect

1 on its passage.".
