## House Bill 3671

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON TAX CREDITS

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires joint legislative interim committee on revenue to study costs and benefits of Oregon's tax credits and make recommendations to Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to tax credits; and prescribing an effective date. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The joint legislative interim committee on revenue, or other appropriate legislative interim committee dealing with issues of revenue and taxation, shall conduct a 5 study of the costs and benefits of Oregon's tax credits. 6 7 (2) Based on the outcome of the study, the interim committee shall make recommen-8 dations to the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly. SECTION 2. This 2011 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2011 9 10 regular session of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 11
