House Bill 5002

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Agriculture for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Agriculture; appropriating

3 money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol-

7 lowing purposes:

10 (2) Food safety \$ 4,883,308

11 (3) Natural resources \$ 3,211,472

12 (4) Agricultural development \$ 2,990,102

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment 15 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-16 cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not 17 described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for 18 the following purposes:

22 (3) Natural resources \$ 14,607,539

23 (4) Agricultural development \$ 11,405,701

24 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 25 \$9,441,326 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 26 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources 27 Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the Oregon Plan, to be used for fish and

2 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 3 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment 4 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2011 Act col-5 lected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following purposes:

11 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$21,970 12 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of 13 expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-14 opment Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for deposit in the County Fair Account 15 established in ORS 565.445, to support county fairs.

16 <u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 18 July 1, 2011.

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
