

House Bill 5010

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Columbia River Gorge Commission for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Columbia River Gorge Commission; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Columbia River Gorge Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) Joint operating program..... \$ 824,377

(2) Commissioner expenses \$ 23,161

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$5,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Columbia River Gorge Commission.

SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
