## House Bill 5021

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for State School Fund. Limits biennial expenditures by department of lottery funds allocated to department for State School Fund.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for State School Fund.

Prohibits and limits certain expenditures from State School Fund.

Establishes maximum amount department may spend from State School Fund each fiscal year of biennium.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for Local Option Equalization Grants Account.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Education; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,183,964,432 for the State School Fund.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$371,918,440 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$340,252 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education for the State School Fund.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, the Department of Education:

- (1) May not expend any moneys from the State School Fund for the administration of ORS 326.133 and 326.136.
- (2) May not expend any moneys from the State School Fund for the contract described in ORS 329.488.
- (3) May expend up to \$1,800,000 from the State School Fund for the purposes of the Oregon Virtual School District.
  - SECTION 5. (1) The Department of Education may not spend more than \$2,889,236,024

- (2) The Department of Education may not spend more than \$2,666,987,099 from the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012.
- SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,400,000 for the Local Option Equalization Grants Account.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
