CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Health Licensing Agency; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Health Licensing Agency and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved as follows:

- (1) **Board of Cosmetology:**
 - (a) **Applications, certificate by reciprocity - per field of practice..... \$ 100**
 - (b) **Original issuance of authorizations to practice:**
 - (A) **Certificate by reciprocity - per field of practice..... \$ 45**
 - (B) **Independent contractor - one year..... \$ 100**
 - (C) **Certificate of Identification (freelance authorization) - one year..... \$ 100**
 - (D) **Facility - one year \$ 110**
 - (c) **Renewal of authorization to practice:**
 - (A) **Practitioner certificate - per field of practice..... \$ 45**
 - (B) **Practitioner certificate online payment - per field of practice..... \$ 40**
 - (C) **Facility - one year \$ 110**
 - (D) **Independent contractor - one year..... \$ 100**
 - (E) **Certificate of Identification (freelance authorization) - one year..... \$ 100**

(d) Delinquency - per year.....	\$	30
(e) Information packets.....	\$	10
(2) State Board of Direct Entry Midwifery, delinquency - per year.....	\$	50
(3) Advisory Council for Electrologists, Permanent Color Technicians and Tattoo Artists:		
(a) Applications:		
(A) Temporary practitioner	\$	50
(B) Event facility	\$	100
(b) Permits:		
(A) Temporary practitioner	\$	20
(B) Event facility:

SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
