

A-Engrossed House Bill 5032

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Land Conservation and Development for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Land Conservation and Development;
3 appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, of which the department may expend up to 54 percent during the period beginning**

7 **July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012, for the following purposes:**

9 (1) Planning program \$ 9,294,175

10 (2) Grant programs \$ 1,599,341

11 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
12 **\$1,363,210 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for**
13 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
14 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of**
15 **Land Conservation and Development.**

16 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
17 **\$5,860,289 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for**
18 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Land**
19 **Conservation and Development.**

20 **SECTION 4. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
21 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
22 **July 1, 2011.**
