SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Military Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal service agreement reimbursements, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Military Department; appropriating money; 3 limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium 6 beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$24,624,329. 7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 8 \$107,548,338 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 9 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts 10 and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal 11 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department. 12 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 13\$286,549,849 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 14 payment of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2 of this 2011 15 Act, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department. SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Oregon Military 16 17 Department from federal funds for debt service on Build America Bonds are not limited.

18 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 20 July 1, 2011.
