## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Secretary of State for certain biennial expenses. Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Secretary of State

Limits certain biennial expenditures by Secretary of State from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Secretary of State; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Secretary of State, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, of which the secretary may expend up to 54 percent during the period beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012, for the following purposes:

13 **(2) Elections Division ...... \$ 6,532,247** 

(3) Archives Division...... \$ 3,510,766

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payments of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Secretary of State, for the following purposes:
