SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to _____ for biennial expenses.]
[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]

[Limits biennial expenditures of _____ from federal funds.]

Adjusts for six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, limitations on expenditures from specified sources collected or received by Oregon Department of Aviation and Department of Veterans' Affairs for specified projects.

Adjusts for six-year period beginning July 1, 2007, limitations on expenditures from specified sources collected or received by Oregon Youth Authority.

Limits for six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Department of Aviation for construction of Aurora State Airport Air Traffic Control Tower.

Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2011] on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (8), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Aviation for the Joseph State Airport runway reconstruction project is increased by \$52,632.

(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for the expenditure of federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Aviation for the Joseph State Airport runway reconstruction project is increased by \$1,000,000.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,695,200 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Aviation for construction of the Aurora State Airport Air Traffic Control Tower.

SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on

1 expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 99, Oregon Laws 2010, for a six-year period
2 beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys
3 or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal
4 funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the acquisition of
5 land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping
6 of the Oregon Veterans' Home Multipurpose Area is increased by \$96,329.

7 (2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
8 established by section 2 (2), chapter 99, Oregon Laws 2010, for a six-year period beginning
9 July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for the expenditure of federal funds, collected or received
10 by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, plan-
11 ning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of the Oregon Veterans'
12 Home Multipurpose Area is increased by \$178,897.

13 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
14 expenditures established by section 1 (4)(e), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for the six-year
15 period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
16 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and
17 federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority for the Corvallis House
18 renovation is decreased by \$1,000,000.

19 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
20 expenditures established by section 1 (7), chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2009, for the six-year period
21 beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
22 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal
23 funds, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority for deferred maintenance is in-
24 creased by \$1,000,000.

25 **SECTION 6.** This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
26 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
27 on its passage.
