

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5052

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “appropriating money; limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 16 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
4 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Develop-**
5 **ment Department established by section 3 (4), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$494,467.**

7 **“(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established**
8 **by section 18 (2)(b)(A), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$494,467.**

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
10 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Education es-**
11 **tablished by section 4, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
12 **2009, is increased by \$18,610,922.**

13 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
14 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Transporta-**
15 **tion established by section 5, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July**
16 **1, 2009, is decreased by \$509,170.**

18 **Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Transportation established**
19 **by section 5a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is de-**

29 **established by section 7, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
30 **2009, is decreased by \$90,912.**

32 **by section 18 (2)(b)(B), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$90,912.**

33 **“SECTION 6. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
34 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Housing and Community**
35 **Services Department established by section 9, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**

1 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$115,571.

2 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services
3 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Housing and Community Services De-
4 partment established by section 9a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium begin-
5 ning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$199,382.

6 “(3) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
7 by section 18 (2)(b)(C), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$314,953.

8 “SECTION 7. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-
9 tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon University System
10 established by section 13, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1,
11 2009, is decreased by \$159,098.

12 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
13 by section 18 (2)(b)(E), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$159,098.

14 “SECTION 8. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-
15 tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Community
16 Colleges and Workforce Development established by section 13a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws
17 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$297,505.

18 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services
19 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Community Colleges and
20 Workforce Development established by section 13b, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the
21 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$299,555.

22 “(3) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
23 by section 18 (2)(b)(H), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$597,060.

24 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
25 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Admin-
26 istrative Services established by section 16, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium
27 beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$983,393.

28 “SECTION 10. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-
29 trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Water Resources De-
30 partment established by section 17, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium
31 beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$7,302.

32 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
33 by section 18 (2)(b)(G), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$7,302.

34 “SECTION 11. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-
35 trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the State Forestry Depart-
36 ment established by section 17a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning
37 July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$3,954.

38 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
39 by section 18 (2)(b)(J), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$3,954.

40 “SECTION 12. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-
41 trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the State Department of
42 Energy established by section 17b, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning
43 July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$73,761.

44 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
45 by section 18 (2)(b)(I), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$73,761.

1 **“SECTION 13. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-**
2 **trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of**
3 **Administrative Services established by section 12, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**
4 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$39,070.**

5 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services**
6 **Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative**
7 **Services established by section 17c, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium begin-**
8 **ning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$1,798,262.**

9 **“(3) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established**
10 **by section 18 (2)(b)(D), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$1,837,332.**

11 **“SECTION 14. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, from the Ad-**
12 **ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Department of Adminis-**
13 **trative Services, the amount of \$323,068 for the purposes of paying, when due, the principal**
14 **and interest on outstanding certificates of participation for projects authorized under chap-**
15 **ter 2, Oregon Laws 2009.**

16 **“SECTION 15. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.”.**
