SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to _____ for biennial expenses.] [Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-ceipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.] [Limits biennial expenditures of _____ from federal funds.] Appropriates, for biennium beginning July 1, 2011, moneys from General Fund to Judicial Department, Department of Human Services, Housing and Community Services Department, Oregon University System and State Department of Agriculture for specified purposes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

2	Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) There is appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium be-
5	ginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,400,000 for the purpose of
6	providing conciliation and mediation services in circuit courts.
7	(2) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall distribute the moneys appropriated un-
8	der this section to the counties of this state to fund conciliation and mediation services in
9	circuit courts. The Chief Justice shall consult with the presiding judges of the circuit courts
10	before making the distributions.
11	SECTION 2. (1) There is appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium be-
12	ginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,400,000 for the purpose of
13	operating law libraries or providing law library services.
14	(2) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall distribute the moneys appropriated un-
15	der this section to the counties of this state based on revenues received from filing fees
16	collected during the 2009-2011 biennium in civil actions commenced in the circuit court for
17	the county.
18	SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium begin-
19	ning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$140,000 for the purpose of ad-
20	ministering the appellate mediation program established under ORS 2.560, including payment
21	of administrative costs and costs of providing mediation services to indigent parties.
22	SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the
23	biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$30,000 for the
24	purpose of funding the administration of ORS 417.805, 417.810 and 417.815 by the Office of

2 <u>SECTION 5.</u> There is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department,

3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$470,000 for

4 the purpose of providing housing for individuals and families with low incomes.

5 <u>SECTION 6.</u> There is appropriated to the Oregon University System, for the biennium 6 beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$330,000 for the purpose of 7 funding clinical legal education programs at accredited institutions of higher education that 8 provide civil legal services to victims of domestic violence, stalking or sexual assault.

9 <u>SECTION 7.</u> There is appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the 10 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000 for the 11 purpose of funding individual farm credit mediations.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
July 1, 2011.

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
