House Concurrent Resolution 10

Sponsored by Representatives HANNA, ROBLAN, Senator COURTNEY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Recognizes the 2010 University of Oregon football program.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas the 2010 football season for the University of Oregon Ducks was one of the greatest
3 in the history of this state; and

4 Whereas the efforts of the University of Oregon football program have propelled Oregon into
5 the national limelight; and

6 Whereas the 2010 football program was the first in school history to achieve a perfect 12-0
7 regular season; and

8 Whereas the University of Oregon has been the outright PAC-10 champion in football for two
9 consecutive seasons; and

10 Whereas the University of Oregon was recognized as the nation's top ranked football team
11 during much of the 2010 season; and

12 Whereas on December 4, 2010, the Oregon Ducks beat their in-state rival in the 114th Civil War
13 game to secure their first-ever berth in the BCS National Championship Game; and

14 Whereas for 2010 Oregon Coach Chip Kelly was the Sporting News College Football Coach of
15 the Year, the Associated Press Coach of the Year, the Football Writers Association of America
16 Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year, the American Football Coaches Association Coach of the Year
17 and the Walter Camp Football Foundation Coach of the Year; and

18 Whereas running back LaMichael James became Oregon's first unanimous All-American, won
19 the Doak Walker Award as the nation's top running back and finished third in the Heisman Trophy
20 balloting (the best ever by a Duck football player); and

21 Whereas Cliff Harris was also named an All-American as a punt returner; and

22 Whereas their efforts, conduct and exemplary play brought pride to all Oregonians; and

23 Whereas the Ducks were the first team from Oregon to play for a national championship in
24 football; now, therefore,

25 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

26 That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, on be-
27 half of all Oregonians, recognize, honor and celebrate the achievements of the University of Oregon
28 football program during the 2010 regular season and the Ducks' playing in the BCS National
29 Championship Game on January 10, 2011; and be it further
