House Concurrent Resolution 18

Sponsored by Representative GILLIAM (at the request of Pheasant Pointe Retirement and Assisted Living Residence)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Declares June 18, 2011, as HUGS Day in Oregon.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas "HUGS" is an acronymn that stands for Humanity United for Good; and

3 Whereas it is believed that the HUGS idea originated at the Pheasant Pointe Retirement and 4 Assisted Living Residence in Molalla, where a HUGS Committee began meeting weekly to decide 5 who within the facility needed a hug that week; and

6 Whereas the purpose of the HUGS idea is to encourage people to work with groups of people

or by themselves to perform good deeds for others in their communities who are in need of help or
just a simple hug; and

9 Whereas the local library and another senior community have become active in the HUGS pro-10 gram at the assisted living facility in Molalla; and

11 Whereas the HUGS idea has spread elsewhere across this country where groups have formed 12 HUGS programs; and

13 Whereas the Legislative Assembly believes that a day to celebrate the HUGS idea would bring

14 more attention to an idea that can make a real difference in people's lives; now, therefore,

15 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

16 We, the members of the Legislative Assembly, declare June 18, 2011, as HUGS Day in Oregon.
