Recognizes and honors Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector (1950-1997) for his service to this state.

2	Whereas Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector was born December 17, 1950, to James
3	Sr. and Rozella Rector, in Bend; and
4	Whereas Sergeant Rector graduated from Bend High School in 1969; and
5	Whereas shortly after graduation Sergeant Rector joined the United States Army and served
6	until 1972; and
7	Whereas Sergeant Rector was a Vietnam War veteran; and
8	Whereas Sergeant Rector married his wife, Carol, in 1969 and had two sons, Scott and David

10	Whereas Sergeant Rector was a loyal and loving husband and father and an active member of
11	the community; and
12	Whereas Sergeant Rector entered the Oregon State Police Recruit School in late 1973 and, upon
13	graduation, was assigned to the Klamath Falls area and was transferred two years later to serve the
14	Gilchrist-Crescent area; and
15	Whereas Sergeant Rector worked with Neighborhood Watch groups and was the Drug Abuse
16	Resistance Education (DARE) officer in the local school; and
17	Whereas Sergeant Rector was named Klamath County State Police Officer of the Year in 1995
18	and received the Oregon Police Officer Medal of Honor; and
19	Whereas Sergeant Rector survived five shoot-outs and two bullet wounds during his 24-year ca-
20	reer; and
21	Whereas Sergeant Rector was killed in the line of duty, along with Oregon State Police Trooper
22	Scott A. Lyons, on September 2, 1997, in a traffic accident while on routine patrol west of Crescent
23	on U.S. Highway 97; now, therefore,
