House Concurrent Resolution 32

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Recognizes and honors Oregon State Police Trooper Dan A. Nelson (1948-1972) for his service to this state.

2	Whereas Oregon State Police Trooper Dan A. Nelson was born on May 18, 1948, to Lewis and
3	Virginia Nelson in Portland; and
4	Whereas Trooper Nelson's dream was to be an Oregon State Police officer since he was young
5	after seeing the many Oregon State Police officers that would stop by and grab breakfast at his
6	parents' restaurant in Pendleton; and
7	Whereas Trooper Nelson graduated from Pendleton High School in Pendleton in 1966; and
8	Whereas Trooper Nelson graduated from Blue Mountain Community College in Pendleton with
9	an associate degree; and
10	Whereas Trooper Nelson continued his schooling at Southern Oregon University in Ashland and,
11	after graduation, was hired by the Ashland City Police Department; and
12	Whereas Trooper Nelson was married on March 22, 1969, to Maryann Petri and together they
13	had two children, Rhondy and Janet; and
14	Whereas Trooper Nelson served in the Ashland City Police Department for three years before
15	being hired by the Oregon State Police in 1972; and
16	Whereas Trooper Nelson was killed in the line of duty on July 28, 1972, at the young age of 24;

18	Whereas Trooper Nelson was killed when struck by a vehicle while issuing a warning to a mo-
19	torist on Interstate 5 in Salem; and
20	Whereas Trooper Nelson was a promising police officer with much potential; now, therefore,
21	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
22	That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Trooper
23	Dan A. Nelson for his service to this state.
