Whereas Oregon State Police Superintendent Holly V. Holcomb was born on January 7, 1917, in Quitman, Mississippi; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb graduated from Vernonia High School and attended Oregon State University, where he was a member of the football team and graduated in 1938; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb entered the Oregon State Police Recruit School in 1939; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb served with the Oregon State Police as a police officer for 36 years; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb was killed in the line of duty on November 25, 1975, in front of the Public Service Building in Salem; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb was a man of great humor and enjoyed telling stories to his family and peers; and

Whereas Superintendent Holcomb was beloved by his fellow troopers; now, therefore,

**Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Superintendent Holly V. Holcomb for his service to this state.
