House Concurrent Resolution 6

Sponsored by Representative WINGARD (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Declares legislative policy in support of fatherhood and promotion of bonds between children and parents by providing children maximum access to parents regardless of marital status.

2	Whereas babies as young as three months of age can distinguish between their mother and fa
3	ther; and
4	Whereas children with involved fathers score higher on cognitive tests; and
5	Whereas improved cognitive ability is associated with higher educational attainment; and
6	Whereas involvement of fathers lessens the likelihood of at-risk children failing or dropping ou
7	of school; and
8	Whereas children with involved fathers experience enhanced career success, leading to highe
9	incomes and greater financial stability; and
10	Whereas children with involved fathers demonstrate lower rates of teen violence, delinquence
11	and other law enforcement problems; and
12	Whereas involvement of fathers is associated with positive child characteristics such a
13	empathy, self-esteem, self-control, psychological well-being, social acceptance and life skills; and
14	Whereas having an involved father provides a role model for positive parenting, health
15	caregiving and commitment to the family; now, therefore,
16	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
17	That the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly declares that it is legislative policy to support
18	fatherhood and to further children's well-being by enhancing the bonds between children and parent
19	through providing children maximum access to their fit and loving parents regardless of the curren
20	marital status of the parents.
