## **House Concurrent Resolution 9**

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Establishes Code of Conduct Joint Committee to develop and propose code of conduct for members of Legislative Assembly during terms of legislative service. Directs committee to submit proposed code of conduct to Legislative Assembly for consideration during 2012 regular session.

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: 2 (1) The Code of Conduct Joint Committee is established. 3 (2) The Code of Conduct Joint Committee shall consist of: 4 (a) Three Senators appointed by the Senate Democratic Leader; 5 (b) Three Senators appointed by the Senate Republican Leader; 6 7 (c) Three Representatives appointed by the House Democratic Leader; and (d) Three Representatives appointed by the House Republican Leader. 8 (3) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall serve as 9 cochairs of the committee. In the event of co-Speakers of the House of Representatives, the co-10 Speakers shall jointly designate a Representative to serve as cochair of the committee. 11 12 (4) The committee shall draft a proposed code of conduct to apply to the conduct of members of the Legislative Assembly during their terms of legislative service. 1314 (5) The committee shall submit the proposed code of conduct to the Legislative Assembly for consideration at the 2012 regular session of the Legislative Assembly. 15
