SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Urges Congress to enact legislation requiring Federal Aviation Administration to expedite approval process for unmanned aircraft testing in rural areas.

JOINT MEMORIAL

2	To the President of the United States and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United
3	States of America, in Congress assembled:
4	We, your memorialists, the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in legis-
5	lative session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:
6	Whereas unmanned aircraft are currently prohibited from flying in general airspace; and
7	Whereas manufacturers of unmanned aircraft require locations for aerial testing; and
8	Whereas it usually takes up to two years to obtain Federal Aviation Administration approval
9	for testing of unmanned aircraft; and
10	Whereas central Oregon has proposed a large remote area for the testing of unmanned aircraft
11	and
12	Whereas manufacturers of unmanned aircraft locating to central Oregon would bring immediate
13	economic benefit to the proposed test area; and
14	Whereas the recent unemployment rate for communities near the proposed test area ranges from
15	a low of approximately 15 percent to a high of 18.6 percent; now, therefore,
16	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
17	(1) The Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to enact
18	legislation that requires the Federal Aviation Administration to develop an expedited approval pro-
19	cess for applications for aerial testing in rural counties with an unemployment rate of 10 percent
20	or higher.
21	(2) A copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President of the United States, to the Senate
22	Majority Leader, to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and to each member of the Oregon
23	Congressional Delegation.
