House Joint Resolution 11

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow Legislative Assembly, or people through initiative process, to enact laws limiting or prohibiting contributions or expenditures made in con-nection with campaigns for nomination or election to public office. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general

election.

1	JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section
4	25 to be added to and made a part of Article II, such section to read:
5	SECTION 25. The Legislative Assembly, or the people through the initiative process, may
6	enact laws limiting or prohibiting contributions or expenditures made in connection with
7	campaigns for nomination or election to public office.

9	PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
10	people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout
11	this state.
