

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 24

1 Deletes lines 16 through 23 of the printed joint resolution and insert:

2 “Whereas school districts may implement financial literacy requirements and should provide fi-
3 nancial literacy courses or otherwise provide opportunities that help students to achieve financial
4 literacy; and

5 “Whereas the Department of Education should assist school districts in teaching financial li-
6 teracy to students and assessing the financial literacy of students by providing school districts with
7 a model financial literacy course or a model program related to financial literacy; and

8 “Whereas a model financial literacy course or a model program related to financial literacy that
9 is provided by the Department of Education to school districts should teach financial management
10 skills, including basic principles involved with earning, spending, saving and investing money; and

11 “Whereas the Department of Education, in preparing a model financial literacy course or a
12 model program related to financial literacy, is encouraged to consider any preexisting courses or
13 programs that are available at no cost to the department; now, therefore,”.

14 Delete lines 25 through 27 and insert:

15 “That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, urge school districts to re-
16 quire students to demonstrate proficiency in financial literacy by successfully completing a one-half
17 credit financial literacy course or a program related to financial literacy prior to graduation.”.
