

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 36

1 Delete lines 14 and 15 of the printed joint resolution and insert:

2 “Whereas school districts should provide a one-half credit course in civics and government ed-
3 ucation or should otherwise provide students with an opportunity to become proficient in civics and
4 government; and”.

5 In line 16, after “civics” insert “and government”.

6 Delete lines 19 and 20 and insert:

7 “That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, urge school districts to re-
8 quire students to become proficient in civics and government by successfully completing a course
9 in civics and government education or by otherwise demonstrating proficiency in civics and gov-
10 ernment prior to graduation.”.
