

Senate Bill 102

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to report to Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly on changes necessary to implement federal health care law.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon Health Authority implementation of federal health care law; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall review the state statutes administered**
6 **by the authority and shall report to the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly any changes**
7 **to the statutes that are necessary to implement the requirements of and the state options**
8 **available under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (P.L. 111-148), as**
9 **amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (P.L. 111-152).**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
