## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires State Department of Agriculture to charge annual permit fees for confined animal feeding operations. [Allows department to adopt by rule schedule of fees for certain inspections.] Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 13 (2) As used in this section[,]:
- 14 (a) "Confined animal feeding operation" has the meaning given that term in rules adopted by
- 15 the [State] department [of Agriculture].

(b) "Large confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in rules
 adopted by the department.

(c) "Medium confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in
 rules adopted by the department.

(d) "Small confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in rules
 adopted by the department.

22 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 561.255 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply only 23 to annual permit fees charged by the State Department of Agriculture for annual permit 24 periods beginning on or after May 15, 2011.

(2) If this 2011 Act becomes effective after May 15, 2011, the department shall issue a
 supplemental billing for additional fees owing by reason of the provisions of subsection (1)

1 of this section.

2 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
on its passage.
