SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Agriculture to charge annual permit fees for confined animal feeding operations. Allows department to adopt by rule schedule of fees for certain inspections.

9 (a) Small confined animal feeding operations, \$100.

10 (b) Medium confined animal feeding operations, \$200.

11 (c) Large confined animal feeding operations, \$300.

(2) The department may adopt by rule a schedule of inspection fees for small confined animal feeding operations, medium confined animal feeding operations and large confined animal feeding operations that allows the department to recover the cost of inspections that are in addition to those set forth in the regular schedule of inspections.

16 [(2)] (3) As used in this section[,]:

(a) "Confined animal feeding operation" has the meaning given that term in rules adopted by
the [State] department [of Agriculture].

(b) "Large confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in rules
adopted by the department.

(c) "Medium confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in
rules adopted by the department.

(d) "Small confined animal feeding operations" has the meaning given that term in rules
adopted by the department.
