SUMMARY

Creates offense of driver operation with obstructing animal. Punishes by maximum fine of \$90.

2	Relating to the offense of driver operation with obstructing animal.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle
5	Code.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of driver operation with obstructing animal
7	if the person is operating a vehicle when an animal is in the operator's lap.
8	(2) The offense described in this section, driver operation with obstructing animal, is a
9	Class D traffic violation.
10	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to offenses that occur on or after the ef-

11 fective date of this 2011 Act.
