

Senate Bill 197

Sponsored by Senator BATES, Representative BUCKLEY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Oregon Health Authority from discriminating based on claims volume in rates of reimbursement for dispensing prescription drugs in medical assistance program.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to dispensing fee reimbursement in medical assistance program; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.**

6 **SECTION 2. The Oregon Health Authority, in establishing the rate of reimbursement for**
7 **a pharmacy's cost of dispensing prescription drugs in the medical assistance program, may**
8 **not discriminate based on the claims volume of a pharmacy.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
