## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 204

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt procedures by rule for health care providers that are also health insurers to safeguard against conflicts between ethical standards for practice of medicine and financial incentives of insurance operations.]

Allows disclosure of identity of person between health care providers and prepaid managed care health services organizations that are paid by state health plan to provide care to person.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 $\mathbf{2}$ Relating to health care. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 192.518 to 192.529. 5 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "entity" means a health care provider or a pre-6 paid managed care health services organization, as defined in ORS 414,736, that provides health care to an individual, if the care is paid for by a state health plan. 8 (2) Notwithstanding ORS 179.505, an entity may disclose the identity of an individual who 9 receives health care from the entity without obtaining an authorization from the individual, 10 or a personal representative of the individual, to another entity for the purpose of coordi-11

nating the health care and treatment provided to the individual by either entity.
