Senate Bill 209

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires hospitals to annually report executive compensation of hospital administrator and to annually report financial relationships between hospital and members of board of directors of hospital.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to hospital administration.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 442.400 to 5 442.463.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In addition to any filing and reporting requirements under ORS 442.420

and 442.425, a hospital shall file annually with the Administrator of the Office for Oregon
Health Policy and Research a report containing the following information:

9 (a) All compensation paid by the hospital to the hospital administrator and any deferred
 10 compensation arrangement between the administrator and the hospital during the prior 12
 11 months; and

(b) Any financial relationship, direct or indirect, that existed between a member of the
 board of directors of the hospital and the hospital during the prior 12 months.

(2) The administrator shall prescribe by rule the form and manner for reporting infor mation under this section.

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
