

Senate Bill 257

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation for former Senator Rick Metsger)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Excludes from definition of "employment," for purposes of unemployment insurance benefits, service performed in operation of passenger motor vehicle operated as taxicab or for nonemergency medical transportation by person with ownership or leasehold interest in vehicle.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to exclusion from the definition of employment; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this chapter, "employment" does not include service per-**
6 **formed in the operation of a passenger motor vehicle that is operated as a taxicab or a pas-**
7 **senger motor vehicle that is operated for nonemergency medical transportation by a person**
8 **who has an ownership or leasehold interest in the passenger motor vehicle.**

9 (2) As used in this section, "leasehold," "passenger motor vehicle that is operated as a
10 taxicab" and "passenger motor vehicle that is operated for nonemergency medical transpor-
11 tation" have the meanings given those terms in ORS 656.027 (28).

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to service performed on or after the ef-**
13 **fective date of this 2011 Act.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
