A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of

6 the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, which may be expended for the purpose of pro-

7 viding assistance with medical transportation to veterans who use wheelchairs.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 10 on its passage.
