

Senate Bill 285

Sponsored by Senator FERRIOLI (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to sell Timms Hamby Computer Archive Center to Harney County for consideration of \$1. Requires Harney County to retire certificates of participation issued for center.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Timms Hamby Computer Archive Center; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Assembly finds that:**

5 (1) **The Timms Hamby Computer Archive Center located in Burns, Oregon, is underuti-**
6 **lized.**

7 (2) **The welfare of residents in rural Harney County is acutely dependent upon developing**
8 **and expanding employment and business opportunities.**

9 (3) **Harney County will use the Timms Hamby Computer Archive Center to pursue eco-**
10 **nomical development to help the region.**

11 **SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall sell the Timms**
12 **Hamby Computer Archive Center located in Burns, Oregon, to Harney County for the con-**
13 **sideration of \$1.**

14 (2) **Harney County shall retire any certificates of participation issued for the center.**

15 (3) **The sale and transfer of the center must be completed on or before January 12, 2012.**

16 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.**
