SUMMARY

Provides for early repeal of pilot project that requires applicants for certain occupational or professional licenses to demonstrate and maintain tax compliance as condition of issuance or renewal of license.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

7 2, 2016] the effective date of this 2011 Act.

8 SECTION 2. This 2011 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2011
