## Senate Bill 313

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## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Repeals statutory provisions establishing Oregon Rainy Day Fund if amendment to Oregon Constitution proposed by Senate Joint Resolution 10 (2011) is approved by people. Provides that transfer of portion of ending balance to Oregon Rainy Day Fund does not occur if amount in fund equals at least 12 percent of General Fund revenues collected during prior biennium.

Takes effect only if Senate Joint Resolution 10 (2011) is approved by people at next regular general election. Takes effect on effective date of constitutional amendment proposed in Senate Joint Resolution 10 (2011).

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund; creating new provisions; amending ORS 293.146, 293.148, 317.853 and 318.074; repealing ORS 293.144; and prescribing an effective date.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - **SECTION 1.** ORS 293.146 is amended to read:
- 6 293.146. (1) As used in this section:

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- (a) "Ending balance" means the difference between the amount of General Fund revenues collected during a biennium and the amount of General Fund appropriations for the biennium.
  - (b) "General Fund appropriations" means the amount of moneys appropriated from the General Fund for a biennium in the legislatively approved budget for the biennium, minus the amount of any General Fund appropriation balances for that biennium that revert to the General Fund under ORS 293.190.
    - (c) "Legislatively approved budget" has the meaning given that term in ORS 291.002.
  - (2) Except as provided in ORS 293.148, as soon as possible after the ending balance for a biennium is determined, an amount equal to one percent of the amount of General Fund appropriations for that biennium shall be transferred to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution. If the ending balance does not equal or exceed one percent of the amount of General Fund appropriations, an amount equal to the ending balance shall be transferred to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund.
    - **SECTION 2.** ORS 293.148 is amended to read:
  - 293.148. (1) If the moneys in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution, just prior to the time of a transfer scheduled under ORS [293.144 (3) or] 293.146 equal at least [7-1/2] 12 percent of the amount of General Fund revenues collected during the prior biennium, moneys that would otherwise be transferred to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund shall be deposited in the General Fund.
  - (2) If the moneys in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund just prior to the time of a transfer scheduled under ORS [293.144 (3) or] 293.146 do not equal at least [7-1/2] 12 percent of the amount of General

Fund revenues collected during the prior biennium, the transfer to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund shall be made regardless of whether that transfer increases the amount in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund to at least [7-1/2] 12 percent of the amount of General Fund revenues collected during the prior biennium.

**SECTION 3.** ORS 317.853 is amended to read:

317.853. (1) For tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2013, any revenue that is received as a result of a rate of tax above six and six-tenths percent imposed under this chapter and that is in excess of the revenue that would be received under this chapter at a rate of six and six-tenths percent shall be deposited into the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution.

(2) Before the end of each biennium, beginning with the biennium ending on June 30, 2015, the Department of Revenue shall estimate the revenue described in subsection (1) of this section that is received during the biennium. An amount equal to that estimate shall be transferred into the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution, on or before June 30 of each odd-numbered year.

**SECTION 4.** ORS 318.074 is amended to read:

318.074. (1) For tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2013, any revenue that is received as a result of a rate of tax above six and six-tenths percent imposed under this chapter and that is in excess of the revenue that would be received under this chapter at a rate of six and six-tenths percent shall be deposited into the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution.

(2) Before the end of each biennium, beginning with the biennium ending on June 30, 2015, the Department of Revenue shall estimate the revenue described in subsection (1) of this section that is received during the biennium. An amount equal to that estimate shall be transferred into the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by [ORS 293.144] section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution, on or before June 30 of each odd-numbered year.

SECTION 5. ORS 293.144 is repealed.

SECTION 6. The Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution, is intended to be a continuation of the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by ORS 293.144. Moneys contained on the effective date of this 2011 Act in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by ORS 293.144 shall remain in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by section 15, Article IX, Oregon Constitution.

SECTION 7. This 2011 Act does not become effective unless the amendment to the Oregon Constitution proposed by Senate Joint Resolution 10 (2011) is approved by the people at the regular general election held in November 2012. This 2011 Act takes effect on the effective date of that amendment.
