SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Increases penalty for crime of riot to maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.]

Repeals provisions relating to pilot treatment program for persons convicted of sex crimes who are eligible for parole or post-prison supervision. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to crime; repealing ORS 144.625, 144.627, 144.629 and 144.631; and declaring an emergency. $\mathbf{2}$

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 144.625, 144.627, 144.629 and 144.631 are repealed. 4

SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public $\mathbf{5}$

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 6
