

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 389**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 2.** (1) A person who files a petition for post-conviction relief under ORS 138.510 to  
3 138.680 and who seeks jury records that are confidential under ORS 10.215 must either include in  
4 the petition a request for access to the confidential records or file a motion in the proceedings  
5 seeking access to the confidential records. A motion under this subsection must be filed not later  
6 than 90 days before the hearing date for the petition, unless the court allows a later filing for good  
7 cause shown. The petition or motion, and any supporting affidavit for the petition or motion, must  
8 be served on the trial court administrator for the court that entered the judgment of conviction and  
9 on the State Court Administrator. The request for confidential records must:”

10 In line 17, after “evidence” insert “relevant to a claim”.
