## Senate Bill 434

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Prohibits licensees of Oregon Liquor Control Commission from manufacturing, importing, storing, delivering, distributing or selling alcoholic beverages containing caffeine or containing other substances used for increasing energy levels.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to alcoholic beverages. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471. SECTION 2. A licensee of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission may not manufacture, 5 import, store, deliver, distribute or sell in this state an alcoholic beverage that has any of 6 7 the following as an ingredient: 8 (1) Caffeine; (2) Guarana or other plants that contain caffeine; 9 10 (3) Tuarine; or (4) Other substances that increase energy levels or are commonly used for increasing 11 energy levels. 12 13
