

Senate Bill 434

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits licensees of Oregon Liquor Control Commission from manufacturing, importing, storing, delivering, distributing or selling alcoholic beverages containing caffeine or containing other substances used for increasing energy levels.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alcoholic beverages.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.**

5 **SECTION 2. A licensee of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission may not manufacture,**
6 **import, store, deliver, distribute or sell in this state an alcoholic beverage that has any of**
7 **the following as an ingredient:**

8 (1) **Caffeine;**

9 (2) **Guarana or other plants that contain caffeine;**

10 (3) **Tuarine; or**

11 (4) **Other substances that increase energy levels or are commonly used for increasing**
12 **energy levels.**
