Senate Bill 443

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Eliminates sunset on provision allowing federal forest reserve moneys in Douglas County road fund and Lane County road fund to be used for law enforcement purposes.

2 Relating to county road funds; creating new provisions; and amending section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read: 5 Sec. 4. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that 6 are received by Douglas County and deposited into its road fund may be expended for the patrolling 7 8 of Douglas County roads by Douglas County law enforcement officials. (2) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that are re-9 ceived by Lane County and deposited into its road fund may be expended for the patrolling of Lane 10 County roads by Lane County law enforcement officials. 11 12 [(3) This section is repealed on January 2, 2014.] [(4) This section applies to moneys described in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that are re-13 ceived before, on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.] 14 SECTION 2. Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 1 of this 15 2011 Act, applies to moneys described in section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, that are 16

received before, on or after September 27, 2007.
