

Senate Bill 443

Sponsored by Senator PROZANSKI; Senators KRUSE, VERGER, Representatives FREEMAN, HOYLE, NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates sunset on provision allowing federal forest reserve moneys in Douglas County road fund and Lane County road fund to be used for law enforcement purposes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to county road funds; creating new provisions; and amending section 4, chapter 894, Oregon
3 Laws 2007.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 4.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that
7 are received by Douglas County and deposited into its road fund may be expended for the patrolling
8 of Douglas County roads by Douglas County law enforcement officials.

9 (2) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that are re-
10 ceived by Lane County and deposited into its road fund may be expended for the patrolling of Lane
11 County roads by Lane County law enforcement officials.

12 *[(3) This section is repealed on January 2, 2014.]*

13 *[(4) This section applies to moneys described in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that are re-*
14 *ceived before, on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.]*

15 **SECTION 2.** Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 1 of this
16 2011 Act, applies to moneys described in section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, that are
17 received before, on or after September 27, 2007.
