SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Specifies requirements for training provided by Department of Education] Requires Department of Education to provide assistance to school districts, government agencies and community groups related to United States Department of Agriculture's Afterschool Meal and Snack Program. Allows Department of Education to award grants related to program. Authorizes department to enter into contract with public or private entity to provide training for and administration of grant program.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for grants and administration of grant program.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

2	Relating to the United States Department of Agriculture's Afterschool Meal and Snack Program;
3	appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall provide assistance to school districts,
6	government agencies and community groups to encourage participation in the United States
7	Department of Agriculture's Afterschool Meal and Snack Program.
8	(2) In addition to the assistance provided under subsection (1) of this section, the de-
9	partment may award grants to school districts, government agencies and community groups
10	to enable participation in the United States Department of Agriculture's Afterschool Meal
11	and Snack Program. Each grant may not exceed \$10,000 and must be used to:
12	(a) Purchase necessary equipment and services required to provide food service and meet
13	sanitation requirements;
14	(b) Make any payment necessary to comply with sanitation requirements that may be
15	required prior to approval; and
16	(c) Fund participant outreach activities and materials.
17	(3) The Department of Education may enter into a contract with a public or private en-
18	tity for the purposes of the entity providing:
19	(a) Technical assistance to applicants for and recipients of grants; and
20	(b) Administration of the grant program.
21	SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
22	ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the
23	General Fund, the amounts of:
24	(1) \$150,000 for the purpose of providing grants to school districts, government agencies

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1 and community groups as described in section 1 of this 2011 Act; and

(2) \$30,000 for the administration of the grant program described in section 1 of this 2011
Act.

4 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 6 July 1, 2011.

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
