

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 505

1 Delete lines 4 through 23 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 396.150 is amended to read:

3 “396.150. (1) The Governor shall appoint an Adjutant General who shall hold office for a four-
4 year term or until:

5 “(a) **The Adjutant General resigns;**

6 “(b) **The Adjutant General is** relieved by reason of [*resignation,*] withdrawal of federal recog-
7 nition; or

8 “(c) **The Adjutant General is relieved by the Governor or** for cause to be determined by a
9 court-martial.

10 “(2) The current term of an Adjutant General continues until its prescribed expiration date
11 while [*such*] **the** Adjutant General is serving in a federal active duty status under an order or call
12 by the President of the United States. Voluntary entry onto extended active duty by a person hold-
13 ing the office of Adjutant General is an automatic resignation of [*such*] **the** officer.

14 “[*(2) A person is eligible for appointment to the office of Adjutant General if the person is an of-*
15 *ficer of the Oregon National Guard, federally recognized in the grade of lieutenant colonel or higher,*
16 *and has completed at least six years' service in the Oregon National Guard as a federally recognized*
17 *officer.*]

18 “(3) The Adjutant General may be appointed in the grade of lieutenant colonel or higher, but
19 not exceeding that of lieutenant general. If appointed in a lower grade, the Adjutant General may
20 be promoted by the Governor to any grade not exceeding that of lieutenant general.”.
