Senate Bill 53

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Deletes obsolete references in law governing Oregon Department of Administrative Services annual charitable fund drive program. Directs department to appoint charitable fund drive committee to set policies for and implement annual charitable fund drive program. Allows committee, with written approval of Director of Oregon Department of Administrative Services, to contract with charitable fund drive management organization.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to annual charitable fund drive program; creating new provisions; and amending ORS
292.045.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 292.045 is amended to read:

6 292.045. [(1) As used in this section, "United Fund" means the organization conducting the single,

7 annual, consolidated effort to secure funds for distribution to agencies engaged in charitable and public

8 health, welfare and service purposes, which is commonly known as the United Fund, or the organiza-

9 tion which serves in place of the United Fund organization in communities where an organization

10 known as the United Fund is not organized.]

11 [(2) Any state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of salaries or wages of state officers 12 or employees is authorized, upon written request of the state officer or employee, to deduct each month 13 from the salary or wages of the officer or employee the amount of money designated by the officer or 14 employee for payment to the United Fund. The moneys so deducted shall be paid over promptly to the 15 United Fund designated by the officer or employee. Subject to any regulations prescribed by the Oregon 16 Department of Administrative Services, the state official authorized to disburse the funds in payment 17 of salaries or wages may prescribe any procedures necessary to carry out this section.]

(1) As used in this section, "annual charitable fund drive program" means the single, annual, consolidated effort conducted by the charitable fund drive committee appointed under subsection (2) of this section to secure funds from state officers or employees for distribution to organizations engaged in charitable, public health, public welfare or service or similar purposes that directly benefit individuals in this state.

(2)(a) The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall appoint
seven members to a charitable fund drive committee. Each member must be an officer or
employee of the State of Oregon. The term of office of a member is two years. A member
may be reappointed to one additional term.

(b) The committee shall set policies for and implement an annual charitable fund drive
program in the manner described by the director by rule.

1 (c) With the written approval of the director, the committee may enter into a contract 2 with a charitable fund drive management organization to administer the annual charitable 3 fund drive program.

4 (3) A state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of salaries or wages of state 5 officers or employees is authorized, upon written request of the officer or employee, to de-6 duct each month from the salary or wages of that officer or employee the amount of money 7 designated by the officer or employee for payment, in the manner designated by the officer 8 or employee, to the annual charitable fund drive program, to a charitable fund drive man-9 agement organization or directly to an organization that participates in the annual charitable 10 fund drive program.

(4) The state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of salaries or wages shall promptly pay the moneys deducted under this section to the annual charitable fund drive program, to a charitable fund drive management organization or directly to an organization that participates in the annual charitable fund drive program.

(5) Subject to rules adopted by the department, the state official authorized to disburse
funds in payment of salaries or wages may prescribe any procedures necessary to carry out
this section.

18 (6) The department may adopt rules necessary to implement this section.

19 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 292.045 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to de-20 ductions and payments of moneys made on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.

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
