SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

[Limits biennial expenditures from federal funds collected or received by department.] Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

36 <u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 37 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 38 July 1, 2011.
