Senate Bill 5505

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Corrections for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Corrections; appropriating money;

3 limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium

beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following

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<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
 \$6,171,725 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for
 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Cor rections.
 <u>SECTION 4.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Department
 of Corrections from federal funds for debt service on Build America Bonds are not limited.

7 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect

- 9 July 1, 2011.
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
