# Senate Bill 5506

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### SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs distribution of moneys from Criminal Fine and Assessment Account. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account; and declaring

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, the

6 Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment

7 Account, reduced by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department

8 of Revenue under ORS 137.300 (6) as specified in sections 3 to 6 of this 2011 Act.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The allocation of the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account
made by this 2011 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such moneys
in prior years.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> There is allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account the amount of \$24,531,611 for the Police Standards and Training Account for criminal justice training and standards operations.
