SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds from Reed Act, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Appropriates moneys from certain federal funds to department for certain purposes.

Appropriates moneys from Employment Department Special Administrative Fund for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds other than federal funds from Reed Act.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium 15 beginning July 1, 2011, out of the funds made available to this state on March 13, 2002, under 16 section 903(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1103(d)), as amended, the amount of 17 \$23,300,000 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for the purposes 18 of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment offices.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the Employment Department Special Administrative Fund created in ORS 657.822, the amount of \$9,500,000 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for the purposes of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment offices.

24 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 25 \$140,492,112 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for

1 payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2011

2 Act collected or received by the Employment Department.

3 SECTION 5. (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Employment

4 Department for unemployment insurance claims from the Unemployment Compensation 5 Trust Fund are not limited.

6 (2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, expenditures by the Employment Department

7 for purposes of carrying out the federal Trade Act and for unemployment insurance claims

8 from federal funds are not limited.

9 <u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
July 1, 2011.
