**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

**Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Employment Relations Board for biennial expenses.**

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [*Employment Relations*] board.

Limits biennial expenditures by board from moneys received from assessment against state agencies.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Employment Relations Board; appropriating money;  
3 limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Employment Relations Board, for the biennium**  
6 **beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$932,803.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$239,750**  
8 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of**  
9 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
10 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds and funds described in section 3 of this 2011 Act,**  
11 **collected or received by the Employment Relations Board.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
13 **\$1,624,757 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for**  
14 **payment of expenses from moneys received from the assessment against state agencies de-**  
15 **scribed in ORS 240.167 and transferred to the Employment Relations Board Administrative**  
16 **Account.**

17 **SECTION 4. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
19 **July 1, 2011.**
