## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Employment Relations Board.

Limits biennial expenditures by board from moneys received from assessment against state agencies.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Employment Relations Board; limiting expenditures;

3 and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 6 \$2,087,965 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 7 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,

<sup>8</sup> but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Employment Re <sup>9</sup> lations Board.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 11 \$1,657,144 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for 12 payment of expenses from moneys received from the assessment against state agencies de-13 scribed in ORS 240.167 and transferred to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services 14 Operating Fund for the Employment Relations Board.

15 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
17 July 1, 2011.
